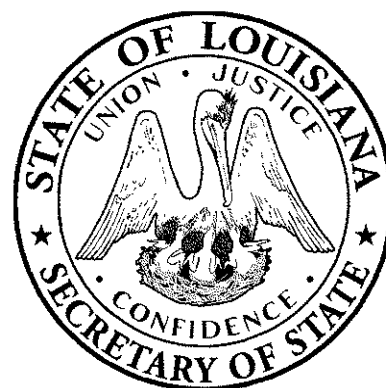

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

Before me, a notary public of St. Tammany Parish, appeared Ricker Goldsborough, who declares that he does hereby incorporate The Cloudbase Foundation, Inc. on this date, November 20, 2009.

ARTICLE I

The name of the incorporator is Ricker Goldsborough, whose address is 4066 Willow Lane; Madisonville, LA 70447.

ARTICLE II

The name of the corporation shall be The Cloudbase Foundation, Inc.

The physical address of the corporation is 4066 Willow Lane; Madisonville, LA 70447. The mailing address of the corporation is 4066 Willow Lane; Madisonville, LA 70447. ARTICLE III

The corporate life is perpetual, and the purpose of the corporation is to enter into any lawful activity for which corporations may be formed under Chapter 2, Title 12, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes (Non-Profit Corporation Law) or the United States of America.

ARTICLE IV

In order to meet the organizational test for exemption under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code the following article is set forth:

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, and, that as a Louisiana nonprofit corporation, there shall be no class of stock issued or outstanding of any kind. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the

purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office including the publishing or distribution of statements. Notwithstanding any other provisions, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the parish in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

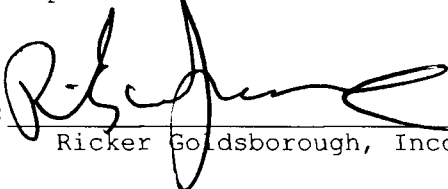
ARTICLE V

There shall be no less than five or no more than nine officers of the Board of Directors, with there being required a President at all times during the life of the corporation. Dual office holding shall only be allowed in regard to the position of Secretary, and/or Treasurer. Officers are selected for life, or until resignation or removal by a majority vote of the Board of Directors, or the stockholders.

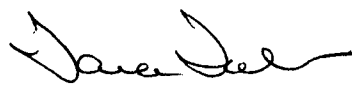
ARTICLE VI

All meetings of the Board of Directors and/or the shareholders of the corporation may only be called by the President (or acting President) of the corporation, except for the annual meeting to be held on May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

The location of the annual meeting shall be selected by the current President of the corporation, within the boundaries of the United States.

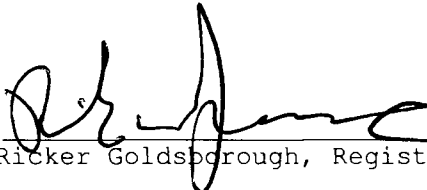
